### Overview

We begin this term with a PSHE focus on being safe with good wellbeing as a priority. We will continue reminding the children of how to keep safe and how to continue good hand washing. In Jigsaw and history we will be looking and talking about our families and how we have changed. In Geography we will be learning about homes, the local area and looking at maps. We will also be finding out about Autumn and learning about Guy Fawkes. We will end the term learning about Christianity and The Nativity.

### PE

### Maths



The children will be learning to:

- Count, read, order and write numbers to 100
- Sequence time and events
- Identify the properties of 2D and 3D shapes
- Complete simple addition - adding 2/3 numbers, adding 1 more within 10
- Know their number bonds up to 10 and 20
- Subtract - 1 less and within 10
- Number bonds - 5 and 10
- Solve mixed addition and subtraction problems (inverse)
- Use money - addition and subtraction, giving change and problem solving
- Recognise patterns, e.g. counting in 2's, 5's and 10's

### English



The children will be learning about:

- Fiction - 'Pumpkin Soup' and 'Farmer Duck'
- Non-fiction - instructions
- Labels and captions
- Reading poems about ourselves, autumn and the senses
- Handwriting - forming letters correctly and sitting the letters on the handwriting lines

### Religious Education

- Christian stories
- The Good Samaritan - kindness
