Overview

Our priority this term is to focus on children's wellbeing and how they can stay safe. We will learn about keeping safe in many aspects but ensure good handwashing practice and good hygiene is of high importance. We will then begin our topic by watching 'Paddington' in our bubbles. In English we will be learning to write our own instructions. In Science, we will be learning about materials and move onto classifying animals as well as learning their basic needs and habitats. In art, children will be learning about a sculpture artist and use their work as inspiration. In RE sessions children will learn about Sikhism and Christianity.

Science



The children will be learning about materials including the scientist Charles Macintosh. Then we will look at classifying and grouping animals. They will learn animals' basic needs and look at different habitats. Following with how they depend on each other.

Maths



The children will be learning to:

- Read, write and spell numbers up to 100 and beyond. Counting in groups of 2,3,5 and 10.
- Number bonds to 10/20/100, e.g. 40+60=100
- Place value - to know what each digit represents
- Sequences, e.g. counting in 2's, 3's, 5's, 10's from odd and even numbers
- Comparing numbers, e.g. 32 is greater than 23
- Odd and even numbers
- Multiplication counting in 2,5,10 and times tables
- Addition/subtraction - add 3 one digit numbers, 2 digit add/subtract 1 digit, 2 digit add/subtract 10 using resources
- Money - recognise different combinations of coins
- Add/subtract money
- Shape - identify properties of 2D and 3D shapes
- Sorting and comparing 2D and 3D shapes
- Measuring - temperature
- Data Handling - Pictograms

English



The children will be learning about:

- Non-fiction - instructions - how to make a marmalade sandwich
- Letter writing - Paddington/Christmas
- Diary Writing - Samuel Pepys
- Information page on keeping safe and animals
