Autumn Term



Maths



The children will be learning about:

- Sorting, counting, ordering and writing numbers 0-20.
- One more and one less than a given number.
- Comparing objects using the language of greater than and less than.
- Partitioning numbers into tens and ones.
- Finding, making and comparing number bonds to 10.
- Using the part whole model to support number bonds to 10.
- Addition within 20.
- Recognising, describing and sorting 2D shapes.
- Solving addition word problems within 10.
- Subtraction within 20, exploring these subtraction facts.
- Comparing addition and subtraction and practically solving these problems.
- Naming describing and sorting 3D shapes.

Science

The children will be learning about:

- The topic in science will begin with Animals. They will learn the categories (birds, fish, mammals, reptiles and amphibians) and what makes the animal fit into this category. We will learn the terms 'carnivore and herbivore' and discuss what each of these groups eat. We will look at which animals are invertebrates and what this means.
- The season of Autumn and what changes we see around us in this time.
- The human body, naming and labelling these parts. They will learn the 5 senses and which body part is associated with this.

English



The children will be learning about:


- Writing labels and captions linked to our Geography and Science learning.

- Reading and writing instructions.
- Plan and structure a non-fiction page.
- Reading, rehearsing and writing poetry.

- Spelling, punctuation and grammar will be taught weekly in this term we will cover sentences and verbs.
