### Maths



#### The children will be learning about:

- Counting forwards, backwards within 100 and using a 100 square
- Place value of numbers within 100
- Partitioning numbers
- Ordering and comparing numbers
- Number bonds to 20
- Related subtraction facts
- Adding 3 numbers
- Name, describe and compare 2D and 3D shapes

### Science

They will know that objects are made from materials such as wood, plastic, glass, metal, water and rock.

Children will know that materials have properties and are useful for a given purpose.

- Writing a letter

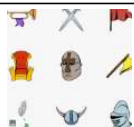
#### Spelling and Punctuation:
