Maths



The children will be learning about:

- Division by sharing between 2, 5 and 10
- Multiplication including repeated addition
- Counting in 2, 3, 5 and 10
- Finding half
- Fractions of a shape and number
- Turns and direction including $\frac{1}{4}$ turns
- Odd and Even numbers
- Addition and Subtraction retrieval
- Using the inverse to check calculations
- Word problems
- Writing numbers in words
- Minutes, hours, days, weeks and ordering time
- Reading and drawing times on clocks including o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to
- Measuring in centimetres and metres
- Comparing and ordering lengths

Science

This term our science topic will be animals. The children will be learning how animals, including humans, have offspring which grow into adults. They will investigate and describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival. Children will describe the importance for humans of exercise. Our science sessions will explore and compare the differences between things that are living, that are dead and that have never been alive. We will explore habitats and describe how animals and plants are suited to their habitat. Our learning of animals will investigate how they obtain their food from plants and other animals, using the idea of a simple food chain.

- Non-fiction texts - information pages contributing to a class book. This will be linked to our WW2 learning in history
- Poetry - Valentines and Mother's Day poems
- Non-fiction - Instruction writing linked to our DT topic
- Fiction - writing stories & world book week

Religious Education

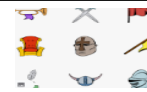
The children will be learning the following:
