<u>English</u>

- Phase 1 or 2 phonics Little Wandle
- Talk for Writing books The Gruffalo' and The Three Little Pigs'. These will be taught using a sensory approach
- Name writing
- Answering questions about pages in a book through pointing or language
- Using phonics to read words
- Sharing a book and developing book skills
- Dough disco, squiggle whilst you wriggle and handwriting sessions
- Big write sessions
- Children will work on their own individualised English targets daily
