**Thursday 14<sup>th</sup> December: Bring an unopened bottle** (e.g. alcohol, sauce, pop, bubble bath, squash etc)

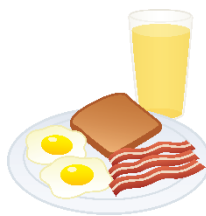
Any other donations for the Christmas Fair are welcome - such as books, teddy bears, unwanted games/toys.
