Make a Puppet Workshop

Dear Parents,

For the D&T workshop, your child will be making a character from 'Little Red Riding Hood' to help them to retell the story.

Over the next couple of days, your children will come home with their design sheet so you know which character they have chosen to make and have an idea of what they want it to look like. The puppet they make should look as close to the design as it can.

We have the following resources in school which will be available for you to use on the day:

PVA glue Fabric Scissors Safety pins 6 x staplers

The children have already tested different ways of joining materials together and their design sheet tells you the way they have chosen. We do not expect you to go out and buy resources, but if your child has chosen to staple and you have a stapler at home then we would be grateful if you could bring this in, along with any other decorative materials you have e.g. felt tips, wool for hair, buttons for eyes, bits of fabric for noses and mouths, ribbons for clothes, etc.

Please come to the main entrance gate that leads onto the main playground at 2pm and a member of staff will let you into the classroom. You are more than welcome to take your child home once the workshop has finished.
